As a **breeding stallion**, Grandioso produces excellent offspring, several of which have gone on to compete at international Grand Prix (including Mejorano HGF). Typically baroque in type, Grandioso excels for his modern movement with uphill expression and extraordinary hind leg action. Grandioso is the rare prototype for the baroque horse with all the benefits for collected work who also displays a high level of ability for the lengthened gaits. He is a Qualified Stallion in the LG-ANNCE studbook (official studbook for the PRE horse in Spain).

In 2018, the American bred Mejorano HGF represented Spain in the World Championships of Young Horses in Ermelo. In 2023 he represented US at the CHIO Rotterdam Nations Cup CDIO4 with Kerrigan Gluch scoring 75.350 at the Freestyle.

Bolero has great conformation and height. He has the beauty and functionality characteristic of the PRE horses. His offspring are acquiring the quality of the sire, that is to say quality in movements, height and beauty. He is an outstanding stallion for sport and breeding.

Bolero CXLVIII was developed by José Daniel Martín Dockx. He achieved several 70% in the top level of Grand Prix. For Kerrigan Gluch, Bolero became her partner for the U25 circuit and received multiple awards in both continents: USA and Europe.

OXIDO

Oxido has a position in the coveted catalog of Young Recommended Breeding Stock for Dressage Conformation by the PRE Studbook, LG-ANCCE. Oxido's bloodlines are a conjunction of Yeguada Mlitar and Yeguada Camacho Benitez, the latter identified by powerful horses, good limbs, large bones, large hooves and well rounded forms.

The grandfather of Oxido, Talisman IV (1982) was very strong and had a great bone structure. As many know, He produced an "I" line of colts that grew into important stallions that had many success in the Dressage Stadiums such as Impaciente II, Iles and Iberis (Oxido's father).





OXIDO

Oxido can repeat the legacy of his grandfather. In 2015 he became the Reserve National Small Tour Champions of Spain. Five years later he debuted in Grand Prix with scores over 70%. Now Oxido is focused on his breeding duties. His lineage from Camacho Benitez, including Navarro VI (by Albero II) and Talisman IV, along with his grey coat will change and shift the new lines for HGF.
